## Executive Summary/ Follow-up Survey

This report is a six-month follow-up of the 2014-2015 graduating class; responses were received from 41 percent of the graduates.

## **Employment Rates**

Eighty-eight percent of respondents are employed, a decrease of 2 percent from 2014; 84 percent of employed respondents work full-time; 14 percent of employed respondents work part-time. Nine percent of employed respondents are seeking employment.

Only 13 unemployed associate and bachelor graduates not working and not enrolled in additional coursework or attending graduate school were actively seeking employment. Sixty-four percent of unemployed respondents were either enrolled in additional academic coursework or had chosen to not seek employment at this time.
