Lesson Plan for Indiana History Baseball

Purpose: To review a unit in Indiana History. (Actually this format can be used for studying almost any subject.)

## Scoring

1. If the batter answers the question correctly and all the fielders are wrong it is a Home Run.
2. If the batter is first with the correct answer and one fielder is also correct it is a Triple.
3. If the batter is first and two fielders are correct it is

a Double.

4. If the batter is first and all three fielders are also correct it is a Single.
5. If the batter is second with the correct answer it is a Walk.

6. If the batter is third with the correct answer it is a Walk.
