USI Student Athletes are:

71st percentile in country on college entrance exams

65th percentile in country on high school GPA: 3.31

85th percentile in country on current collegiate GPA

75th percentile in country on single year retention rates

92nd percentile in country on federal graduation rate

When comparing the federal graduation rate between the student body and student athletes, student athletes are in the 99 percentile. This translates to participation in a NCAA Division II sport means the student athlete is very likely to remain at USI and graduate from USI.
